Anderson enjoyed fishing, boating, water skiing, and spending time with his grandchildren.

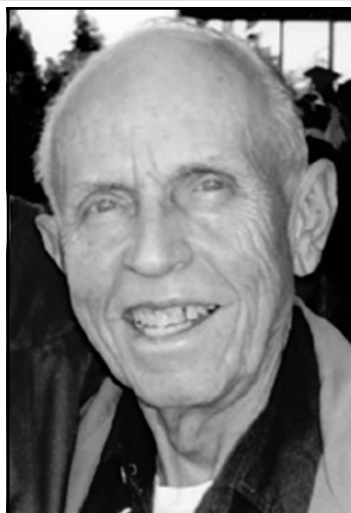
Anderson served in the Navy during the Korean War. He worked for Safeway Stores Inc. for 35 years.

#### Clarence (Clancy) Heisler

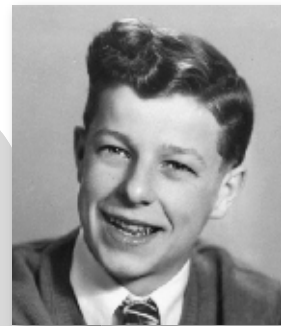
